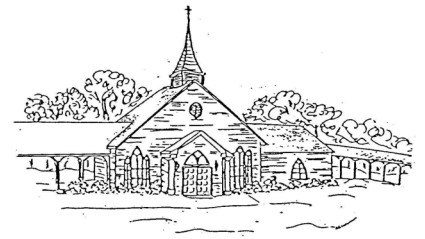

Dear People of Annunciation,

I am very excited to announce that our community of Vidalia is beginning a feeding ministry to the homeless and we can be a part of this wonderful opportunity!!

Recently, I attended a meeting at Lyons City Hall and at Vidalia City Hall to discuss the growing awareness that Toombs County has a large homeless population. At both of these meetings there were city officials, police officers, clergy, from several different denominations, and others interested in helping. Many in our community have begun to discern that something needs to be done to provide the appropriate services to help those experiencing homelessness, and services to prevent homelessness for those at risk.

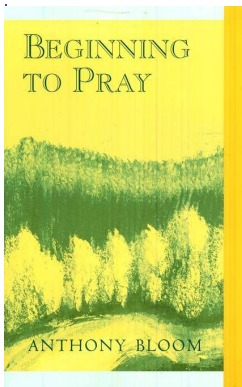
I have had the opportunity in two communities I lived in to help start a ministry to the homeless. As I experienced, and many in Toombs County know, it's difficult to start anything like this without money, and the only way we can access grant money to provide services is to get numbers. The hard work of counting the number of homeless in Toombs County has not been done in the past, so to help do this, we are starting a feeding ministry. Once a week, starting in March on Thursday evenings at Becoming One Outreach Ministries, dinner will be provided by a different church, or group.

I have signed Annunciation up to provide food and fellowship on Thursday, March 23. Volunteers Are Needed! The food we provide on March 23 will need to be prepared at Annunciation that day. Our support will be needed from 5-7:15pm to help with setup, serving and cleanup. Flyers will be distributed to those in need by The Martha Eliza Foundation, Inc. headed by Ms. Belva Franklin.

My hope is this ministry takes off, not only in our community of Vidalia but with many of you who will give it a try and discover how rewarding it is to reach out to help our sisters and brothers in need. Please let me know if you are interested in helping.

The 1Book1Diocese read for Lent is a classic work, *Beginning to Pray* by Anthony Bloom. *This simple and powerful book, gets at the vital importance of encountering God in prayer.*

Oak Bench in Memory of Father Ron Southerland

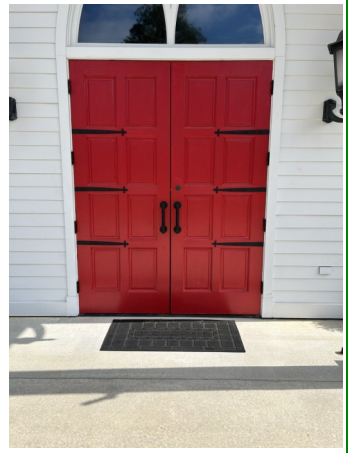

Vestry Meeting Minutes – Annunciation – January 22, 2023 at 11:45 am

Meeting was opened with prayer by Rev. Denise at 12:15 pm, following lunch shared by members.

Vestry Meditation was read and discussed.

Vestry Meeting minutes for December 2022 were submitted by email for review and approval; approved by General Consent.

Treasurer's Report: (Rev. Denise for Christina) Financial Report for December 2022 was presented for review. December Income was \$20,028.58. December Expenses were \$12,410.37. Net Income for December was \$7618.21. Balance in checking account at end of December was \$2405.37; Rev. Denise made note that balance in checking account as of 1/18/2023 is \$33,061.00, due to deposits made since end of December. Amount in Max and Christy Manry Memorial State Street Global Advisors Account is \$157,782.35 as of 12/31/2022. Amount in Bank of America Church Corp Investment Account as of 12/31/2022 is \$214,016.87. Current amount in Ameris Money Market Account is \$1198.13. Income and expenses are typical for this time of year. Frank moved to approve the December Financial Report, 2nd by Carol, motion passed.

Senior Warden's Report: Dorsey was not present.

Junior Warden's Report: (Frank) Frank is bringing his crew to work on long list of repairs this Thursday and Friday. Jack Dell has volunteered to paint the front door.

Rector's Report: (Rev. Denise) Annual Parish Meeting will be held on Sunday, 1/29, after 10:30 am service with lunch provided. New Vestry will have a short meeting after Annual Meeting. ECW Coffee Hour will be held on Sunday, 2/12. Vestry meeting will be held on Sunday 2/19 after 10:30 am service. Rev. Denise will be out of town February 21 – March 2. Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper will be from 5:30 pm to 7 pm on 2/21. Ash Wednesday Services will be led by Ken Shradar at 12 noon and 5:30 pm on 2/22. Ken will also lead Morning Prayer on 2/26. Diocesan Ultreya will be held on 4/15/2023 at Annunciation. Bishop Frank Logue will visit on 4/16/2023. Video streaming volunteers are needed at 10:30 am services.

Business:

1. Annual Budget Report for January through December 2022 was presented for review. Gross Profit for 2022 was \$168,256.87 and includes \$31,140 that was withdrawn from our Bank of America Church Corp Investment Account and our Money Market Account. Extra funds were needed in 2022 to pay for the new roof that was put on the office building; this expense was the reason for additional withdrawals that were made from our investment accounts. Total expenses for 2022 were \$169,353.70. The year of 2022 ended with a deficit of \$1,096.83.
2. Proposed budget for 2023 was presented for review. Gross profit for 2023 is projected to be \$144,500.00. Total expenses for 2023 are projected to be \$162,028.88. Projected deficit for 2023 is \$17,528.88. Frank moved to approve the 2023 Budget, 2nd by Twalla, motion passed.
3. Seventeen pledges in the amount of \$104,960 have been received for 2023. Budget for 2023, approved today, will be presented at Annual Parish Meeting.

Ministry Area Reports: Already covered.

Meeting was adjourned with Lord's Prayer at 1:50 pm.
