

Tell Out My Soul

Every Valley: An Advent Reflection

Each year as the calendar turns to Advent, I find myself thumbing through my music library to pull up The Messiah. Best known for its ending movements and the rousing Hallelujah Chorus, the first movement is my favorite, and the one I begin humming to myself in early December. The prophets tell us of a great power, a person to come, who will level the field and reveal the right path. "Every valley shall be exalted," the Tenor boldly asserts!

Whether it is the Tenor stepping forward for the first solo aria, or visions of a prophet standing in a rocky, winding landscape, the effect is the same: a great work starts with a promise, with a proud proclamation, with someone to point the way. The prophet has something exciting to share with us, something so important that the barriers that stand in the way of hearing and acting on their words will melt away. There is an exchange happening here: the prophet has something to share, and we, who hear the message, have something to receive. When we do, the shock waves of those words will batter down mountains and smooth the rough edges within us.

This same transformation happens when we share our gifts with the church. Our investments of time, talent, and treasure are the natural response to having heard the words of the prophet and having been changed by their message. However you respond to the prophet, the world around you is being made ready to receive what you will share with it. And in every direction, as the chorus answers the Tenor, "The Glory of the Lord will be revealed." TENS.org



Questions for Reflection:

As you ease into Advent this year, pay attention to the tug of the prophet – what is it that you are hearing? How does it cause you to act? Does it fill you with the urge to share that good news and goodness with others?



What is Operation Christmas Child?

The Samaritan's Purse project Operation Christmas Child collects shoebox gifts—filled with fun toys, school supplies and hygiene items—and delivers them to children in need around the world to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way. For many of these children, the gift-filled shoebox is the first gift they have ever received. Since 1993, Operation Christmas Child, the world's largest Christmas project of its kind, has collected and delivered more than 146 million shoebox gifts to children in more than 160 countries and territories.



Anyone can pack a shoebox. **Do not include:** candy; toothpaste, used or damaged items; war related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures; seeds; chocolate or food; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items, such as snow globes or glass containers; or aerosol cans.

Meeting was opened with prayer at 12:10 pm. Vestry Meditation was completed.

Vestry Meeting Minutes for August 2025 were reviewed; Kristen moved to approve minutes, 2nd by Len, motion passed.

Financial Report: (Rebecca) Financial report for August 2025 was reviewed. Income for August was \$13,028.00.00; Expenses for August were \$12,144.81. Net Income for August was \$ 883.19. Balance in Church Corporation Bank of America Investment Account as of June 30 was \$252,972.27. Balance in Max and Christy Manry Memorial State Street Investment Account as of August 31 is \$169,261.22. Request for withdrawal of \$10,000 from Manry State Street Investment Account has been made. Balance in Church Restricted Funds as of 8/31/2025 is \$37,198.41. Kristen moved to approve the August financial report, 2nd by Len, motion passed.

Senior Warden's Report: No Report – Carol Absent

Junior Warden's Report: (Len) Two windows in Narthex continue to need sealing. Weeding and trimming of shrubbery is needed. Rebecca will coordinate the work. Mario and Patty will help put up third sign that has been down since it was hit by a car; post is needed.

Rector's Report: (Rev. Denise) Sarah Solis will attend New Beginnings Weekend on September 19-21. Rev. Denise will be out of town on September 16-24. Morning Prayer will be held on Sunday, September 21. Rev. Denise will attend Clergy Conference September 22-24 in Eatonton; Clergy from Diocese of Atlanta and Diocese of Georgia will participate. Episcopal Church Women's Coffee Hour will be September 28. Tell Out My Soul Stewardship Letter from Senior Warden will be in October Newsletter. Letter from Stewardship Chair, Hugh Jordan, with Pledge Card will be sent during the week of October 6. ECW Coffee Hour will be Sunday, October 12. Cursillo Closing Service will be on Sunday, October 19 at 3 pm; Rev. Denise, Spiritual Chair of the Cursillo Commission, will celebrate and preach at Honey Creek during the closing service. Church has camera and sound system; computer is needed, as well as capable people willing to operate the computer. Rev. Denise has information about what computer system is needed and will find it.
3. Members also discussed the possibility of having a system that allows for electronic donations. Len will investigate what is needed for cash.app. Rebecca will check on venmo.com.
