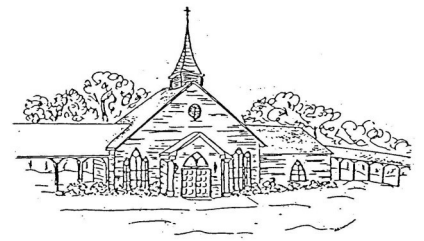

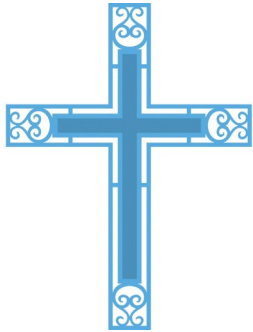

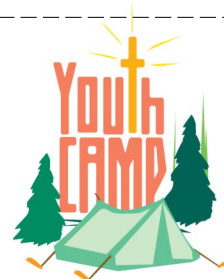

Meeting was opened with prayer at 12:15 pm following lunch.

Minutes of Short Called Vestry Meeting on 1/25/2026 were reviewed; Carol moved to approve minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Connie, motion passed.

Minutes of Special Vestry Meeting Minutes on 1/25/2026 were reviewed; Rebecca moved to approve minutes, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristen, motion passed.

Vestry Meeting Minutes for February 15 were reviewed; Rebecca moved to approve minutes with one correction, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kristen, motion passed.

Financial Report: (Rev. Denise and Rebecca) Financial report for February 2026 was reviewed. Income for February was \$ 8,370.00. Expenses for February were \$14,989.98. Net Income for February was \$ - 6619.98. Balance in Church Corporation Bank of America Investment Account as of December 31 is \$269,871.14. Balance in Max and Christy Manry Memorial State Street Investment Account as of February 28 is \$173,875.51. Balance in Church Restricted Funds as of 2/28/2026 is \$37,593.03. Connie moved to approve the February financial report, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carol, motion passed.

Senior Warden's Report: (Carol) Rev. Denise is retiring. She will be honored with a drop-in retirement reception on her last Sunday, April 12 from 12:00 – 2:30 pm in the Parish Hall. Vestry is giving Rev. Denise a farewell monetary gift in the amount of \$10,000.00 on behalf of the congregation of Annunciation.

Junior Warden's Report: (Rev. Denise for Len) Portico posts painting still needed. Sealing of two windows in Narthex still needed. Carpets in church and in offices have been cleaned. A door is needed for Karen's office. Rebecca will measure the opening; she may have a door that will work. Door may need a window.

Rector's Report: (Rev. Denise) ECW Coffee Hour will be held on Palm Sunday, March 29. Altar will be stripped on Maundy Thursday, April 2. Good Friday Services at 12 noon and 6 pm on April 3. Church will be decorated for Easter on Holy Saturday, April 4 at 11 am. Easter Sunday Service will be followed by Reception and Egg Hunt on April 5. Morning Prayer services and supply services are scheduled through end of this year. A master calendar that has everything on it will be in the office. Canon to the Ordinary Loren Lasch will celebrate Eucharist on Sunday, April 19. She will meet with parishioners and with Vestry to answer questions and provide guidance as we begin our transition activities. Morning Prayer Service will be led by Larry Threlkeld on April 26. Canon Joshuar Varner will celebrate Eucharist on Sunday, May 3. When we have a supply priest here, the 8 am service will be held at 9 am. When we have Morning Prayer, there will be one service at 10:30 am. All the worship info for bulletins is on flash drive that Karen will have access to. Rev. Denise plans to meet with LEM's, Lectors, and Altar Guild before leaving. There will be a short Vestry Meeting on Rev. Denise's last Sunday here, April 12, at 9:45 am. May Vestry Meeting will be held at 11:45 am on Sunday, May 17.

Business:

1. Rebecca moved that we re-activate the Vestryperson-In-Charge (VIC) position, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carol, motion passed. Beginning on April 19, Rebecca will serve as VIC at the 9:00 am service (or ask a parishioner to sub for her if needed) and rest of Vestry members will take turns serving as VIC at 10:30 am service. VIC will unlock and lock doors, turn lights on and off, adjust AC/Heat appropriately, and make sure that services run smoothly. VIC signup is completed through end of May.
2. Rebecca moved that a Search Committee be formed that is separate from the Vestry, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Carol, motion passed.
3. Jack and Lynette Dell are moving to a retirement setting in Lawrenceville, GA to be close to their daughter. They will be honored with a farewell reception and gift after the 10:30 am Morning Prayer Service on April 26, their last Sunday in Vidalia.
4. New chair for Columbarium will be Harry Moses. New chair for Altar Guild will be Susan Threlkeld.
5. Food Pantry will continue with new hours: 9 am – 2 pm on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday; Beverly, as Outreach Chair, will communicate with parishioners when supplies are needed for Food Pantry.
